Lignacite is committed to sustaining an Environmental Management System which is compliant, as a minimum, with ISO14001:2015. Operational controls, together with objectives, targets and programmes have been established to support this commitment.

This includes co-operating with management on any environment related matter.

All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfill the requirements of this policy.
