

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT OF INTENT

We are committed to attaining and maintaining the highest standards of health and safety (H&S) performance. All persons conducting activities for, or under the control of the company shall adhere to this policy.

The company shall deliver the requirements of this policy by:

- Providing safe and healthy working conditions for the prevention of work related injury and/or ill health
- Continually improving the H&S management system through the ongoing use of strategic H&S objectives
- Fulfilling relevant H&S legal (and other) requirements applicable to its activities
- Using suitable risk assessment processes to eliminate hazards wherever possible and reduce H&S risks
- Consulting on H&S matters and ensuring the participation of workers and their representatives
- Demonstrating a visible management commitment to high standards of H&S performance
- Promoting a positive H&S culture throughout the company
- Providing and maintaining a safe working environment, together with adequate facilities and arrangements for the welfare of employees
- Providing and maintaining safe plant, equipment and systems of work
- Providing and maintaining a safe means of access and egress to and from the workplace
- Having in place adequate arrangements to ensure safety in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances
- Providing such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure the health and safety of those working on behalf of the company
