NVCS LTD acknowledges and accepts its statutory responsibility under the terms of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, regarding the Health, Safety and Welfare of its employees.

In achieving this NVCS will pay particular attention to the following:

- · Preventing accidents and cases of work related ill health
- Maintaining safe and healthy work conditions, providing and maintaining vehicles equipment and appliances and ensuring the safe storage and use of substances
- Provide sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to enable employees to avoid hazardous situations
- Carry out risk assessments, site surveys
- Provide a working environment which have adequate facilities and arrangements for staff welfare
- Implement emergency evacuation procedures in case of a fire or other significant incident
- Engaging and consulting with employees on Health and Safety issues and providing advice and supervision on occupational health.
- Include Health and Safety into planning, organising, controlling, monitoring and review arrangements of its Management Systems
