


## **WENTWORTH**

1500m<sup>2</sup> BESPOKE TEMPORARY ROOF, SCAFFOLDING AND ACCESS ON GRADE 1 ICON







A flagship Lyndon SGB project for the past two years and still ongoing, Wentworth Woodhouse has given us the opportunity to showcase many of our team's skills. And multiple unique challenges were met and overcome on this Grade 1 listed iconic project.

Designed in-house, the 16,000+ square foot (the equivalent of six tennis courts in size) Lyndon SGB temporary roof provided safe and dry weather protection for the Woodhead Group contractors to renovate this historically important building safely.

More than 700 tonnes and 50,000 metres of bespoke, in-house Lyndon SGB designed CUPLOK® system scaffold was used for the main frame of scaffold, incorporating heavy duty beams and ground anchors. And staircases were designed in place to provide rare public access to the main viewing area... all done with an average of 10 Lyndon SGB scaffolding operatives on site.
